- 6 (d) "Commission" means the Maryland Higher Education Commission.
- 7 (e) "DEVELOPMENTAL EDUCATION COURSE" MEANS A NONCREDIT 8 COURSE THAT MUST BE COMPLETED SUCCESSFULLY BEFORE OR CONCURRENT 9 WITH A STUDENT ENROLLING IN A CREDIT-BEARING COURSE.
- 10 **(F)** "Full-time equivalent student" means the quotient of the number of student credit hours produced in the fiscal year 2 years prior to the fiscal year for which the State appropriation is calculated divided by 30, as certified by the Maryland Higher Education Commission.
- [(f)](G) "Officer" means the president and the vice presidents of the College and other officers as shall be appointed by the Board of Trustees.
- 16 [(g)](H) "Secretary" means the Secretary of Higher Education.
- [(h)](I) "State appropriation" means the amount of money for Baltimore City Community College operating funds to be provided each fiscal year to the Board of Trustees by the State.
- [(i)](J) (1) ["Student] EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, "STUDENT credit hours" means student credit hours or contact hours which are eligible, under the regulations issued by the Maryland Higher Education Commission, for inclusion in State funding calculations.
- 24 (2) FOR STUDENTS ENROLLED IN DEVELOPMENTAL EDUCATION 25 COURSES, "STUDENT CREDIT HOURS" MAY INCLUDE ONLY:
- 26 (I) THE CONTACT HOURS OF STUDENTS WHO ACHIEVE A 27 GRADE OF "C" OR BETTER IN A DEVELOPMENTAL EDUCATION COURSE 28 MULTIPLIED BY 1.0; AND

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That it is the intent of the
General Assembly that any reduction of State aid to the community colleges that
results from this Act may not be recouped by the community colleges through an
increase in tuition or fees charged for developmental education courses.

5 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 2014.
