## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Premises Inspections**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Calvert County Board of License Commissioners,  
4 or its designee, to inspect each licensed premises in the county, rather than  
5 requiring the Board to inspect every licensed premises in the county at least  
6 once every 3 months; making certain stylistic changes; and generally relating to  
7 alcoholic beverages in Calvert County.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages  
10 Section 16–402  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2011 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article 2B – Alcoholic Beverages**

16 16–402.

17 In Calvert County, the Board of License Commissioners [shall], **OR ITS**  
18 **DESIGNEE, MAY** inspect [every] **EACH** licensed premises in the county [at least once  
19 every three months].

20 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
21 July 1, 2014.
