## 2 Calvert County – Alcoholic Beverages – Organizational Licenses

- FOR the purpose of establishing an organizational license in Calvert County; authorizing the license to be issued to a fraternal <del>or civic</del> organization, <u>volunteer fire department</u>, or <u>volunteer rescue squad</u> for use on certain premises; authorizing the licensee to sell beer, wine, and liquor by the drink for consumption on the licensed premises only; providing for an annual license fee of \$500; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages licenses in Calvert County.
