18	(a) [All] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION		
19	ALL inspections of funeral establishments shall be unannounced and may take place		
20	at any time without notice from the Board.		
21	(b) An unannounced inspection may include advance notice that an		
22	[investigator] INSPECTOR may be in the region of the funeral establishment FOR THE		
23	PURPOSE OF CONDUCTING AN INSPECTION[,] if:		
24	(1) The advance notice is no more than 14 days prior to the inspection;		
25	(2) No specific date or time is provided for the inspection; and		
26	(3) The advance notice is provided solely to ensure that a licensed		
27	mortician or funeral director will be on–site for the inspection.		
28	(C) A LICENSEE OR AN EMPLOYEE OF A LICENSEE SHALL GIVE		
29	IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO A MEMBER OR AN EMPLOYEE TRAINED STAFF OF THE		
30	BOARD WHO ARE QUALIFIED TO DO INSPECTIONS AND WHO ARRIVES ARRIVE AT

1	(I) IN RESPONSE TO VALID INFORMATION PROVIDED TO
2	THE BOARD RESULTING IN A COMPLAINT BEING OPENED BY THE BOARD
3	CONCERNING THE PREPARATION OR BODY STORAGE AREAS OF A LICENSED
4	FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT ONLY IF THE BOARD HAS PROVIDED A COPY OF THE
5	COMPLAINT TO THE LICENSED FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT; OR
6	(II) OF A FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT THAT THE BOARD HAS
7	PLACED ON PROBATIONARY STATUS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 7–316(B) OF THIS

9	(2) A TRAINED STAFF MEMBER OF THE BOARD WHO IS QUALIFIED
10	TO DO INSPECTIONS MAY CALL THE SUPERVISING MORTICIAN OF A LICENSED
11	FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT, AS DESIGNATED UNDER § 7-310(E) OF THIS TITLE,
12	AND REQUEST IMMEDIATE ACCESS TO THE PREPARATION AND BODY STORAGE
13	AREAS OF THE FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT.
14	(3) If a request is made under paragraph (2) of this
15	SUBSECTION, THE SUPERVISING MORTICIAN IMMEDIATELY SHALL PROVIDE THE
16	STAFF MEMBER OF THE BOARD WITH THE LOCATION OF THE KEY OR ACCESS
17	CODE TO THE PREPARATION OR BODY STORAGE AREAS OF THE FUNERAL
18	ESTABLISHMENT.
19	(4) An employee of a licensed funeral establishment is
20	NOT REQUIRED TO ACCOMPANY A STAFF MEMBER OF THE BOARD WHILE THE

23	(D) AN UNANNOUNCED INSPECTION OF A LICENSED FUNERAL
24	ESTABLISHMENT SHALL BE CONDUCTED DURING THE HOURS THAT THE

26	FUNERAL ESTABLISHMENT.
