- 22 (a) This section applies to any person who is required under Subtitle 2, 7, 8,
- 23 9, or 10 of this title to be licensed to guide fishing parties or to catch, sell, buy, process,
- 24 transport, export, or otherwise deal in fish caught in tidal waters.
