- 4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Comptroller to include on certain income tax forms a 5 demonstrative representation of how much of each dollar that the General Fund 6 receives is spent on certain categories; providing that the representation may be 7 in graphical or pictorial form; requiring the Comptroller, in consultation with 8 the Department of Budget and Management and the Department of Legislative 9 Services, to make certain determinations; requiring the Comptroller to post the representation on the Comptroller's Web site and to include it in certain 10 instructions on the Web site; and generally relating to a requirement that the 11 12 Comptroller include certain information on certain tax forms.

- 3 (a) (1) Subject to the requirements of § 2–110 of this subtitle and subsection (b) of this section, the Comptroller shall design the returns and other forms that, on completion, provide the information required for the administration of the tax laws listed in § 2–102 of this subtitle.
- 7 (2) THE COMPTROLLER SHALL INCLUDE ON THE INCOME TAX
 8 FORMS REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS SECTION THAT ARE
