Calvert County - Alcoholic Beverages - Special Event (Charity) Beer, Wine and Liquor License

4 FOR the purpose of establishing in Calvert County a special event (charity) beer, wine $\mathbf{5}$ and liquor (on-sale) license; specifying the type of organization or group of 6 individuals to which the Board of License Commissioners may issue the license, 7 subject to certain limitations; specifying that the license authorizes a holder to 8 hold and sell alcoholic beverages at a certain event; requiring a holder to have a 9 person certified by an alcohol awareness program on the premises of a certain special event; requiring a holder to certify to the Board that the license holder 10 11 has transferred transfer all of the proceeds from the sale of alcoholic beverages 12 at a certain special event to a certain account; specifying a license fee; 13 authorizing the Board to adopt certain regulations; and generally relating to alcoholic beverages in Calvert County. 14
