A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Education – Children With Disabilities – Habilitative Services Information**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring a local school system to provide to the parents of a child
4 with a disability certain information about access to habilitative services at
5 certain times; and generally relating to providing information on habilitative
6 services for children with disabilities by a local school system.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

14 **Article – Education**

15 **8–418.**

16 **A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM SHALL PROVIDE TO THE PARENTS OF A CHILD**
17 **WITH A DISABILITY VERBAL AND WRITTEN INFORMATION ABOUT ACCESS TO**
18 **HABILITATIVE SERVICES, INCLUDING A COPY OF THE MARYLAND INSURANCE**
19 **ADMINISTRATION’S PARENTS’ GUIDE TO HABILITATIVE SERVICES, AT THE**
20 **FOLLOWING TIMES:**

21 **(1) THE TRANSITION MEETING FOR A CHILD MOVING FROM THE**
22 **MARYLAND INFANTS AND TODDLERS PROGRAM TO A LOCAL SCHOOL SYSTEM;**

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS INDICATE MATTER ADDED TO EXISTING LAW.

1 **(2) A CHILD'S INITIAL INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM**
2 **MEETING;**

3 **(3) AT LEAST ONE TIME EACH YEAR AT A CHILD'S**
4 **INDIVIDUALIZED EDUCATION PROGRAM MEETING; AND**

5 **(4) ON THE APPROVAL OR DENIAL OF A PARENT'S REQUEST FOR**
6 **A RELATED SERVICE TO ENABLE A CHILD WITH A DISABILITY TO BENEFIT FROM**
7 **SPECIAL EDUCATION.**

8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
9 July 1, 2014.
