- 1 (A) THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FINDS THAT THE BALTIMORE CITY
  2 PUBLIC SCHOOLS' 10-YEAR PLAN FOR PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITIES IS A VITAL
  3 COMPONENT TO NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION AND COMMUNITY
  4 DEVELOPMENT IN THE CITY.
- 5 (B) TO ADVANCE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION AND COMMUNITY 6 DEVELOPMENT EFFORTS, THE BOARD SHALL PROVIDE TO RESIDENTS AND 7 COMMUNITY LEADERS IN EACH NEIGHBORHOOD OR GEOGRAPHIC LOCATION 8 THAT SURROUNDS A PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY THAT IS IDENTIFIED FOR 9 REPLACEMENT, RENOVATION, OR CLOSURE IN THE BALTIMORE CITY PUBLIC 10 SCHOOLS' 10–YEAR PLAN:
- 11 (1) A SCHEDULE OF PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY PROJECTS IN THE 12 NEIGHBORHOOD; AND
- 13 (2) AN OPPORTUNITY TO COORDINATE NEIGHBORHOOD
  14 REVITALIZATION AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EFFORTS WITH A SCHOOL
  15 DESIGN TEAM FOR THE PUBLIC SCHOOL FACILITY PROJECTS IN THEIR
  16 NEIGHBORHOODS.
- 17 (C) THE COORDINATING COMMITTEE ESTABLISHED IN THE 18 MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING AS REQUIRED UNDER § 10–646(E) OF THE 19 ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT ARTICLE SHALL:
- 20 (1) PROVIDE AN OPPORTUNITY TO RESIDENTS AND COMMUNITY
  21 LEADERS TO COMMUNICATE THEIR NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION AND
  22 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT EFFORTS AND GOALS TO THE COORDINATING
  23 COMMITTEE;
- 24 (2) CONSULT WITH APPROPRIATE STATE AGENCIES THAT MAY 25 ASSIST WITH NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION AND COMMUNITY 26 DEVELOPMENT; AND
- 27 (3) MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE MAYOR AND CITY 28 COUNCIL OF BALTIMORE CITY TO INCLUDE, AS APPROPRIATE, FUNDING FOR 29 NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS 30 IN THE OPERATING OR CAPITAL BUDGET OF BALTIMORE CITY.
- 31 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 32 July 1, 2014.
