## CHAPTER \_\_\_\_\_

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Election Law – Baltimore City Republican Party Central Committee – Filling**  
3 **of Vacancies**

4 FOR the purpose of providing that an individual appointed to fill a vacancy of a  
5 member of the Baltimore City Republican Party Central Committee may reside  
6 anywhere in Baltimore City; and generally relating to the Baltimore City  
7 Republican Party Central Committee.

8 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,  
9 Article – Election Law  
10 Section 4–203(b)(2)  
11 Annotated Code of Maryland  
12 (2010 Replacement Volume and 2013 Supplement)

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Election Law**

16 4–203.

17 (b) (2) (i) The members of the Republican Party Central Committee  
18 shall be elected from each councilmanic district of Baltimore City.

4 MEMBER OF THE REPUBLICAN PARTY CENTRAL COMMITTEE MAY RESIDE  
5 ANYWHERE IN BALTIMORE CITY.

6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
7 June 1, 2014.
