16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Chapter 280 of the Acts of 2005, as amended by Chapter 21 of the Acts of 2006**
19 **and Chapter 624 of the Acts of 2008**

 4 further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be
 5 abrogated and of no further force and effect. Section 5 of this Act shall remain
 6 effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2007, with no further action
 7 required by the General Assembly, Section 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no
 8 further force and effect.

11 SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 13 of
 12 this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005. Section 3 of this Act shall remain
 13 effective for a period of [10] **20** years and, at the end of June 30, [2015] **2025**, with no
 14 further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be
 15 abrogated and of no further force and effect. Section 5 of this Act shall remain
 16 effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2007, with no further action
 17 required by the General Assembly, Section 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no
 18 further force and effect.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
 20 October 1, 2014.
