## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Community Health Resources Commission – Sunset Extension**

3 FOR the purpose of extending the termination date for certain provisions of law  
4 related to the Maryland Community Health Resources Commission; and  
5 generally relating to the Maryland Community Health Resources Commission.

16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
17 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

18 **Chapter 280 of the Acts of 2005, as amended by Chapter 21 of the Acts of 2006**  
19 **and Chapter 624 of the Acts of 2008**

20 SECTION 14. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, subject to Section 13 of  
21 this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2005. Section 3 of this Act shall remain  
22 effective for a period of [10] **20** years and, at the end of June 30, [2015] **2025**, with no  
23 further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be  
24 abrogated and of no further force and effect. Section 5 of this Act shall remain  
25 effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2007, with no further action

8 further action required by the General Assembly, Section 3 of this Act shall be  
9 abrogated and of no further force and effect. Section 5 of this Act shall remain  
10 effective for a period of 2 years and, at the end of June 30, 2007, with no further action  
11 required by the General Assembly, Section 5 of this Act shall be abrogated and of no  
12 further force and effect.

13 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect  
14 October 1, 2014.
