- 16 (i) \$20 for a daily tasting license, which may be issued not more
- than 12 times in any annual license year;
- 18 (ii) \$200 annually for a 26-day tasting license, which may be
- 19 used consecutively or nonconsecutively;
- 20 (iii) \$300 annually for a 52-day tasting license, which may be
- 21 used consecutively or nonconsecutively; and
- (iv) \$750 annually for a tasting license that may be used daily
- 23 throughout the year.
- 24 (2) The fees for a Class BWLT license are in addition to the Class A
- 25 annual license fee.
- 26 (d) (1) A Class BWLT license authorizes the holder to allow the
- 27 on-premises consumption of beer, light wine, and liquor for tasting or sampling.
- 28 (2) A person may consume beer, light wine, or liquor covered by a
- 29 Class BWLT license in a quantity not exceeding:
- 30 (i) 1 ounce of light wine from a given brand in a single day;

	(ii)	3 ounces of beer from a given brand in a single day; and
	(iii)	One-half ounce of liquor from a given brand in a single da
