**Prince George's County - Board of Education - Elected Member Vacancy -
Approval of Appointment
PG 422-14**

This bill requires the Prince George's County Executive to transmit to the clerk of the Prince George's County Council the name of an appointee to fill the vacancy of a seat that was held by an elected member of the Prince George's County Board of Education. Such an appointment is considered approved unless the county council disapproves by a two-thirds vote within 45 days after the submittal of the name of the appointee.

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None.

Local Effect: None. The Prince George's County Executive can submit the name of an appointee, and the county council can hold the required votes, with existing resources.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Prince George's County Executive must appoint a qualified individual to fill the vacancy of a seat that was held by an elected member of the Prince George's County Board of Education for the remainder of the term. A two-thirds vote of the county council is required to reject such an appointment.
