<p>Anne Arundel County, Maryland is the Grantee Organization. The Department, in consort with the Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works, will secure an architectural and engineering firm to design the park facility. Construction will begin in fiscal year 2015 upon completion of the design effort. The quality of the County's facilities and programs is a testament to the County's ability to manage and operate this project.</p>

The design and construction of this single story, 5,000 square foot building and the associated finger pier structure for oyster hatchery will incorporate an educational hands-on wet lab, Chesapeake associated displays, and oyster hatchery program. This environmental educational building will draw visitors from throughout the County as well as adjacent jurisdictions. This project will also increase the number of students visiting Downs Park for educational field trips.
