11. Description and Purpose of Project (Limit Length to Visible area)

The grant funds would be used to purchase and 3-story light-service elevator in an existing shaft to provide visitor and staff access. The Havre de Grace Maritime Museum is establishing an environmental education center, which will include research and educational laboratory, a class room and new exhibit gallery spaces on the ground floor (approximately 2800 square feet) of the three story building. Currently, there is no access to the ground floor from the main galleries and restrooms and the second floor (collections storage and research). As the building is in the coastal flood plan, no restroom is permitted on the ground floor. As we plan to open the Environmental Center to the public, we must comply with the American with Disabilities Act (ADA) for equal access.

The intent of the project is three-fold; to provide access to the new Environmental Center to be located on the ground floor and with several exhibits on the buildings main floor. We are unable to install a restroom on the ground floor as it is in the floodplain per Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) rules; and to provide access direct access between floors to address a need per the American with Disabilities Act (ADA).

28. Comments: (Limit Length to Visible area)

The ground floor space is partially finished and includes an existing classroom. We recently received a second grant from the Crystal Trust Foundation and two smaller grants form the JM Huber Corporation and the owners of Stack and Store, and donations from several other individuals to finish and equip the space.

Significant accomplishments in our Environmental Center project include:

We leveraged Foundation funds to secure a matching grant of \$3450 from the Baltimore Gas and Electric (BGE) Company to install environmentally friendly lighting. This work is complete.

We are working with several major companies that have corporate offices in the area, to assist us in outfitting and staffing the planned classrooms and laboratory. The J.M. Huber Company has committed, in concept, to provide company funding and assist us in the Centers design.

The City of Havre de Grace issued a resolution (see attachment) in support of the Environmental Center.

Harford County, Maryland's Environmentality education working group is assisting us in developing our environmental and sustainability education programs.

We are developing our Center's education curriculum.

We are currently developing our laboratory equipment, classroom and information technology and management needs.

Note that the \$72,000 equipment cost includes installation by the manufacturers representative. The additional \$3,000 is for electrical and emergency telephone service, and for the finishing of the entrances to the elevator shaft. Estimated recurring operations and maintenance (O&M) costs are approximately \$2400/year including, annual inspections, emergency telephone service and routine servicing and repairs.

The Museum owns the building and leases the property from the City of Havre de Grace, MD. The elevator shaft was built and permitted in the original construction.
