## **11. Description and Purpose of Project** (Limit Length to Visible area)

The EPICENTER occupies a 20,000sf space in a previously-abandoned retail strip on Rt 40 in Edgewood. Through funding by Mountain Christian Church, Fidelity Engineering, Merritt Properties, Aaron's Furniture, and other community organizations, the initial build-out was completed in September 2013. Parts of the project were left incomplete due to budget constraints.

The current project will:

-add 2 showers, which were in the original drawing but later cut out of the budget

-insulate & add a drop ceiling to a large area in the rear of the building, thus making it more usable, since it is quite cold right now.

-add a room in this same area near the back of the building

-build in a storage locker area for the belongings of the many children who are in the building daily
