AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 1312 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, strike "prepare a certain public access plan" and substitute "<u>consider the feasibility of providing certain public access</u>"; in line 10, strike "local governing bodies" and substitute "<u>subdivisions</u>"; strike beginning with "prepare" in line 10 down through "plans" in line 11 and substitute "<u>consider the feasibility of providing certain public access</u>"; strike beginning with "and" in line 12 down through "land" in line 14; in line 21, after "(c)," insert "<u>and</u>"; and in lines 21 and 22, strike "and (b)(2), and 5-906(b)".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 11, 17, and 23, in each instance, strike "MAXIMUM".

On page 3, in line 7, strike "TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT FEASIBLE"; in lines 23 and 24, strike "TO THE MAXIMUM EXTENT FEASIBLE"; in line 21 after "(5)" insert "(1)"; in line 22, strike "PREPARE AND SUBMIT A PLAN" and substitute "<u>CONSIDER</u> <u>WHETHER IT IS FEASIBLE</u>"; and after line 24, insert:

"(II) WHEN CONSIDERING WHETHER IT IS FEASIBLE TO PROVIDE PUBLIC ACCESS TO A SITE UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH, THE DEPARTMENT MAY CONSIDER:

1. <u>THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS AVAILABLE UNDER</u> THIS PROGRAM OR FROM OTHER SOURCES TO PROVIDE PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE <u>SITE;</u>

2. <u>PUBLIC SAFETY AND LIABILITY ISSUES IF PUBLIC</u> ACCESS WERE PROVIDED TO THE SITE;

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3. WHETHER THE SITE WAS ACQUIRED AS A PART OF A LARGER RECREATIONAL AND OPEN SPACE PROJECT THAT IS NOT YET COMPLETED AND READY FOR PUBLIC ACCESS; AND

4. THE EXISTENCE OF A CONTRACTUAL COMMITMENT ON THE SITE THAT WOULD LIMIT PUBLIC ACCESS FOR A PERIOD OF TIME, INCLUDING A HOME, AGRICULTURAL, OR HUNTING LEASE.".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 32, strike "PARTICIPATING LOCAL GOVERNING BODY" and substitute "<u>SUBDIVISION, FOR EACH PROPOSED PROJECT UNDER THIS</u> <u>SUBSECTION</u>"; and strike the colon and substitute "<u>CONSIDER WHETHER IT IS</u> <u>FEASIBLE TO PROVIDE PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE PROPOSED PROJECT.</u>".

On page 5, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 7, inclusive, and substitute:

"(IV) WHEN CONSIDERING WHETHER IT IS FEASIBLE TO PROVIDE PUBLIC ACCESS TO A PROPOSED PROJECT UNDER THIS PARAGRAPH, A SUBDIVISION MAY CONSIDER:

1. <u>THE AVAILABILITY OF FUNDS AVAILABLE UNDER</u> THIS PROGRAM OR FROM OTHER SOURCES TO PROVIDE PUBLIC ACCESS TO THE PROPOSED PROJECT;

2. <u>PUBLIC SAFETY AND LIABILITY ISSUES IF PUBLIC</u> ACCESS WERE PROVIDED TO THE SITE;

3. WHETHER THE SITE FOR THE PROPOSED PROJECT WAS ACQUIRED AS A PART OF A LARGER RECREATIONAL AND OPEN

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SPACE PROJECT THAT IS NOT YET COMPLETED AND READY FOR PUBLIC ACCESS; AND

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<u>4.</u> <u>THE EXISTENCE OF A CONTRACTUAL</u> <u>COMMITMENT ON THE SITE FOR A PROPOSED PROJECT THAT WOULD LIMIT</u> <u>PUBLIC ACCESS FOR A PERIOD OF TIME, INCLUDING A HOME, AGRICULTURAL,</u> <u>OR HUNTING LEASE.</u>";

and strike in their entirety lines 8 through 32, inclusive.
