# AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, after "Buildings" insert "- Maryland Green Building Council"; in line 4, after "projects;" insert "requiring the Maryland Green Building Council to establish a process for receiving public input;"; in line 6, after "buildings" insert "and the Maryland Green Building Council"; and in line 9, after "3-602.1" insert "and 4-809(f)".

## AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 6, after "STANDARD" insert "REVIEWED AND RECOMMENDED BY THE MARYLAND GREEN BUILDING COUNCIL AND"; in line 7, strike the first "SECRETARY" and substitute "SECRETARIES"; and in the same line, strike "THE SECRETARY OF".

# AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, after line 14, insert:

### "4-809.

- (f) The Maryland Green Building Council shall:
  - (1) evaluate current high performance building technologies;
- (2) provide recommendations concerning the most cost-effective green building technologies that the State might consider requiring in the construction of State facilities, including consideration of the additional cost associated with the various technologies;

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- (3) provide recommendations concerning how to expand green building in the State; [and]
- (4) <u>develop a list of building types for which green building technologies should not be applied, taking into consideration the operational aspects of facilities evaluated, and the utility of a waiver process where appropriate; AND</u>
  - (5) ESTABLISH A PROCESS FOR RECEIVING PUBLIC INPUT.".
