AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 118 (First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike in their entirety lines 2 and 3 and substitute "<u>Task Force to</u> <u>Study the Impact of Ocean Acidification on State Waters</u>"; strike beginning with "requiring" in line 4 down through "acidification" in line 9 and substitute "<u>establishing</u> <u>the Task Force to Study the Impact of Ocean Acidification on State Waters</u>; providing for the composition, chair, and staffing of the Task Force; prohibiting a member of the <u>Task Force from receiving certain compensation</u>, but authorizing the reimbursement of certain expenses; requiring the Task Force to analyze certain information and make recommendations regarding certain matters; requiring the Task Force to report its findings and recommendations to the Governor and the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the <u>Task Force to Study the Impact of Ocean Acidification on State Waters</u>"; and strike in their entirety lines 10 through 14, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 1 and 2, strike beginning with "That" in line 16 on page 1 down through "Department." in line 29 on page 2 and substitute "<u>That:</u>

(a) <u>There is a Task Force to Study the Impact of Ocean Acidification on State</u> <u>Waters.</u>

- (b) <u>The Task Force consists of the following members:</u>
 - (1) the Secretary of Natural Resources, or the Secretary's designee;
 - (2) the Secretary of the Environment, or the Secretary's designee; and
 - (3) the following members, appointed by the Governor:

- (i) <u>one representative of the State's aquaculture industry;</u>
- (ii) one representative of the Maryland Watermen's Association;
- (iii) one representative of the National Aquarium, Baltimore;

(iv) one representative of the University of Maryland Center for Environmental Science; and

- (v) one representative of the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.
- (c) <u>The Governor shall designate the chair of the Task Force.</u>

(d) <u>The Department of Natural Resources shall provide staff for the Task</u> <u>Force.</u>

- (e) <u>A member of the Task Force:</u>
 - (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but

(2) is entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.

(f) <u>The Task Force shall:</u>

(1) <u>analyze the best available science regarding ocean acidification</u> and the potential effects of acidification on the ecology of State waters and on State fisheries; and

(2) <u>make recommendations regarding potential strategies to mitigate</u> the effects of acidification on State waters and on State fisheries.

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(g) <u>On or before January 1, 2015, the Task Force shall report its findings and</u> recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.".

On page 2, in line 31, strike "October 1, 2014" and substitute "July 1, 2014. It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and, at the end of June 30, 2015, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect".
