AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert "<u>EMERGENCY BILL</u>"; in the sponsor line, strike "Senator Conway" and substitute "<u>Senators Conway and Waugh</u>"; in line 2, strike "Hunting – Repeal" and substitute "<u>Management Permit</u>"; strike beginning with "repealing" in line 11 down through "permit;" in line 16 and substitute "<u>authorizing an</u> <u>individual who holds a certain permit to use a certain rifle in certain locations and under</u> <u>certain conditions in Charles County and St. Mary's County; providing that a certain</u> <u>permit is valid for a certain period of time each year; authorizing the Department to</u> <u>authorize an individual to hunt deer on Sundays in Charles County and St. Mary's</u> <u>County under certain circumstances;</u>"; strike beginning with "repealing" in line 18 down through "circumstances;" in line 20; and in line 20, after "provision;" insert "<u>making this</u> <u>Act an emergency measure;</u>".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 22, strike the bracket; and in line 27, after "shotgun" insert "<u>OR</u> <u>BREECH LOADING CENTER FIRED RIFLE</u>".

On page 4, strike beginning with "The" in line 1 down through "years." in line 3 and substitute "<u>A DEER MANAGEMENT PERMIT SHALL BE VALID FOR THE PERIOD</u> <u>AUGUST 1 THROUGH JULY 31, OF EACH YEAR.</u>"; in line 4, strike "not"; strike beginning with the colon in line 6 down through "Restrict" in line 9 and substitute "<u>RESTRICT</u>"; in line 9, strike the bracket; in the same line, after "deer" insert "<u>UNDER</u> <u>A DEER MANAGEMENT PERMIT</u>"; in lines 10, 16, and 23, in each instance, strike the bracket; in lines 10, 16, and 23, strike "(D)", "(E)", and "(F)", respectively; and in line 26, strike "(G)" and substitute "<u>(H)</u>".

On page 5, strike beginning with "shall" in line 5 down through "2015" in line 6 and substitute "<u>is an emergency measure</u>, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health or safety, has been passed by a yea and nay vote supported by threefifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted".
