17 18	[(i)](1) Shall keep and make available for public inspection any lien register that an authority provides to the clerk under this section; AND
19 20	[(ii)](2) Shall record and index in the lien register any entry that the authority certifies[; and
21 22	(iii) Is entitled to a fee of 5 cents for each entry that the clerk makes under this section.
