15 16 17 18	(a) [The clerk of the circuit court shall provide a hospital lien docket.] On the filing of a notice of lien under the provisions of this subtitle, the clerk OF THE CIRCUIT COURT shall enter in the [hospital lien docket] JUDGMENT DOCKET OF THE COURT OR IN THE SAME MANNER AS A JUDGMENT:
19	(1) The name of the injured patient;
20	(2) The name of the person alleged to be liable for the patient's injuries;

- (4) The name of the hospital making the claim.
 (b) The clerk shall index the hospital lien under the name of the injured patient.
- 2 (b) The cierk shall index the hospital lien under the name of the injured patient.
- 3 (c) (1) On presentation of a release of a lien, the clerk shall note in the docket 4 the date when the release was filed and shall note on the release that it was recorded.
- 5 **(2)** A release bearing a note that it was recorded or a notation in the docket showing the release constitutes prima facie evidence of the release of the lien.
- 7 (d) **(1)** The clerk shall collect not more than \$2 for the filing, recording, and 8 indexing of each lien.
- 9 **(2)** [He] **THE CLERK** also shall collect not more than \$2 for filing a release 10 of the lien and for noting the filing of the release in the docket and on the release.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
