AN ACT concerning
Real Property - Manufactured Homes - Recording of Affidavits of Affixation and Severance - Fees

FOR the purpose of clarifying that certain fees that the clerk of a circuit court may charge for recording an affidavit of affixation or an affidavit of severance for a manufactured home shall be set by the State Court Administrator; and generally relating to recording fees.

BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article - Real Property Section 8B-202(e) and 8B-302(c) Annotated Code of Maryland (2010 Replacement Volume and 2014 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Real Property

8B-202.
(e) The clerk of the circuit court of the county in which the parcel of real property to which a manufactured home is or will be affixed is located:
(1) Shall accept an affidavit of affixation and any attachments for recordation and indexing; and
(2) May charge a reasonable fee SET BY THE STATE COURT ADMINISTRATOR for the recordation.
