FOR the purpose of requiring that the name of each candidate seeking election to the Montgomery County Board of Education appear on the primary election ballot if the number of candidates seeking election to the county board is equal to or less than the number of nominations available in a primary election; and generally relating to primary election ballots for the Montgomery County Board of Education.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## Article - Education

3-901.
(b) The Montgomery County Board consists of:
(1) 5 elected members, each of whom resides in a different board of education district;
(2) 2 elected members who may reside anywhere in the county; and
(3) 1 student member.
(d) Members of the Montgomery County Board shall be elected at the general election every 2 years as required by subsection (f) of this section.
(f) (2) (I) Elected members of the county board shall be elected by the voters of the entire county.
(II) IF THE NUMBER OF CANDIDATES SEEKING ELECTION TO THE COUNTY BOARD IS EQUAL TO OR LESS THAN THE NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS AVAILABLE IN A PRIMARY ELECTION, THE NAME OF EACH CANDIDATE SEEKING ELECTION TO THE COUNTY BOARD SHALL STILL APPEAR ON THE PRIMARY ELECTION BALLOT.

## Article - Election Law

8-801.
Except as otherwise provided in this subtitle and in Title 3 of the Education Article, the provisions of this article relating to the nomination and election of candidates to public office shall govern the nomination and election of members to an elected county board of education.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 1, 2015.
