3 **Termination Provisions and Sunset Program Evaluation**

4 FOR the purpose of altering the date of the termination provisions relating to the statutory
5 and regulatory authority of the State Board of Morticians and Funeral Directors;
6 altering the date of the requirement that a certain evaluation of the Board and the
7 statutes and regulations that relate to the Board be performed by the Department of
8 Legislative Services; and generally relating to the State Board of Morticians and
9 Funeral Directors and the alteration of dates for termination provisions and the
10 Sunset Evaluation Program.
