- 3 FOR the purpose of altering in Charles County fees for holders of certain alcoholic beverages licenses; altering in Charles County an annual fee for providing live 4 5 entertainment or outdoor table service by a holder of a Class B-R (restaurant) 6 on-sale beer, wine and liquor license, Class B-RB (restaurant/bar) on-sale beer, 7 wine and liquor license, Class B-T (tavern) on-sale beer, wine and liquor license, Class B-N (nightclub) on-sale beer, wine and liquor license, or Class B-H (hotel) 8 9 on-sale beer, wine and liquor license Class D beer license, Class H beer and light 10 wine license, Class D beer and light wine license, Class C beer, wine and liquor 11 license, and Class D beer, wine and liquor license; and generally relating to fees for 12 holders of alcoholic beverages licenses in Charles County.



The fee for this permit is [\$25] \$45.
