- 1 (II) THE SECRETARY MAY DESIGNATE ONE OF THE STAFF AS AN 2 EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR.
- 3 (3) (I) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR SHALL MANAGE THE STAFF OF THE BOARD AND PERFORM ADMINISTRATIVE FUNCTIONS TO CARRY OUT THE POWERS AND DUTIES OF THE BOARD AS PROVIDED FOR UNDER THIS TITLE.
- 6 (II) THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR MAY NOT DIRECTLY CONDUCT 7 INVESTIGATIONS OR INSPECTIONS ON BEHALF OF THE BOARD.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 9 1, 2015.
