- consistent with the purposes of this subtitle, to try to achieve an overall minimum of [0.5%] 17
- 5% of the unit's total dollar value of procurement contracts to be made directly or indirectly 18
- 19 with veteran-owned small business enterprises.
- 20 Solicitation documents shall establish the expected degree of veteran-owned 21

 - (c) The provisions of this subtitle do not apply to a unit's procurement procedures to the extent that any unit determines that those provisions are in conflict with an applicable federal program.
