- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

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1 Operates primarily for the purpose of providing surgical services (i) $\mathbf{2}$ to patients requiring a period of postoperative observation but not requiring [overnight] hospitalization IN WHICH THE EXPECTED DURATION OF SERVICES WOULD EXCEED 24 3 4 HOURS FOLLOWING ADMISSION: and (ii) Seeks reimbursement from payors as an ambulatory surgery $\mathbf{5}$ 6 center. 7 (2)"Ambulatory surgical facility" does not include: 8 (i) The office of one or more health care practitioners seeking only 9 professional reimbursement for the provisions of medical services, unless: 10 1. The office operates under contract or other agreement with a payor as an ambulatory surgical facility regardless of whether it is paid a technical 11 12or facility fee; or 13 2.The office is designated to receive ambulatory surgical 14referrals in accordance with utilization review or other policies adopted by a payor; 15(ii) Any facility or service owned or operated by a hospital and 16regulated under Subtitle 2 of this title; 17(iii) The office of a health care practitioner with not more than one 18operating room if: 19 1. The office does not receive a technical or facility fee; and 202.The operating room is used exclusively by the health care practitioner for patients of the health care practitioner; 2122The office of a group of health care practitioners with not more (iv) than one operating room if: 23241. The office does not receive a technical or facility fee; and 252.The operating room is used exclusively by members of the group practice for patients of the group practice; or 2627An office owned or operated by one or more dentists licensed (v) under the Health Occupations Article. 2829SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 30 October 1, 2015.
