- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

3	(II) "PASSENGER AREA" DOES NOT INCLUDE:
4	1. A LOCKED GLOVE COMPARTMENT;
5	2. THE TRUNK OF A MOTOR VEHICLE; OR
6	3. IF A MOTOR VEHICLE IS NOT EQUIPPED WITH A
