A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

Department of Health and Mental Hygiene – Award of Grant – Study of Past Practices at State Psychiatric Institutions

FOR the purpose of requiring, on or before a certain date, the Department of Health and 4 $\mathbf{5}$ Mental Hygiene to award a grant to a nonprofit organization to conduct a certain 6 study of the past practices regarding the treatment of patients at State psychiatric 7 institutions; requiring, on or before a certain date, the nonprofit organization 8 awarded the grant to submit the results of the study to the President of the Senate, 9 the Speaker of the House of Delegates, and certain committees of the General Assembly; and generally relating to a grant for the study of past practices at State 1011 psychiatric institutions.

12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,13 That:

14 (a) On or before January 1, 2016, the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene 15 shall award a grant to a nonprofit organization to:

16 (1) study the past practices regarding the treatment of patients at State 17 psychiatric institutions; and

consider the past practices in the context of:

19 (i) national and international past practices regarding the 20 treatment of patients in psychiatric institutions; and

(ii) prevailing theories regarding the treatment of individuals with
mental illness at the time the practices were used.

23 (b) On or before December 1, 2016, the nonprofit organization shall submit the 24 results of the study conducted under subsection (a) of this section to the President of the

Senate, the Speaker of the House of Delegates, the Senate Education, Health, and
Environmental Affairs Committee, and the House Health and Government Operations
Committee, in accordance with § 2–1246 of the State Government Article.

4 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 5 October 1, 2015.
