1 A person shall have a permit issued under this subtitle before the person carries, 2 wears, or transports a handgun.

4 A PERMIT ISSUED BY ANOTHER STATE TO AN INDIVIDUAL TO CARRY A 5 HANDGUN, INCLUDING A CONCEALED HANDGUN, IS VALID IN THIS STATE.
