School Bus Monitoring Cameras - Local Jurisdictions - Civil Penalty

- FOR the purpose of authorizing the governing body of a local jurisdiction to establish a civil penalty, not exceeding a certain amount, for violations relating to overtaking and passing a school vehicle that are recorded by a school bus monitoring camera; repealing a requirement that the District Court prescribe a certain civil penalty altering the maximum civil penalty that the District Court may prescribe for a violation recorded by a school bus monitoring camera; and generally relating to civil penalties for violations recorded by school bus monitoring cameras.

1 2 3 4	(e) (1) Unless the driver of the motor vehicle received a citation from a police officer at the time of the violation, the owner or, in accordance with subsection (h)(5) of this section, the driver of a motor vehicle is subject to a civil penalty if the motor vehicle is recorded by a school bus monitoring camera during the commission of a violation.
5 6	(2) A LOCAL JURISDICTION MAY ESTABLISH A civil penalty under this subsection [may not exceed \$250] NOT EXCEEDING \$500 .
7	(3) For purposes of this section, the District Court shall prescribe ! :
