- (b) Except as otherwise provided in this section, any person convicted of a misdemeanor for the violation of any of the provisions of the Maryland Vehicle Law is subject to a fine of not more than \$500.
 - (FF) A PERSON WHO IS CONVICTED OF COMMITTING A VIOLATION OF § 21–801.1 OF THIS ARTICLE ("EXCEEDING MAXIMUM SPEED LIMITS") WHILE OPERATING A MOTORCYCLE THAT IS EXCEEDING THE SPEED LIMIT BY 40 MILES PER HOUR OR GREATER IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY IS SUBJECT TO A FINE OF \$1,000.
