BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 10-410(a)(1)Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2014 Supplement) BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Natural Resources Section 10-410(a)(2)Annotated Code of Maryland (2012 Replacement Volume and 2014 Supplement) SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: Article - Natural Resources 10-410.

6 7	C. \triangleq One Sunday in the second half of January, as designated by the Department;
