# Health Insurance – Expense Reimbursement Claims Forms – Methods for Submission

4 FOR the purpose of requiring certain insurers, nonprofit health service plans, and health  $\mathbf{5}$ maintenance organizations to permit an insured, a subscriber, or a member to 6 submit a claim for reimbursement for certain expenses by first-class mail and by 7 facsimile transmission or through a certain Web site; requiring certain insurers, 8 nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations annually to 9 provide a certain notice and certain instructions; specifying when certain insurers, 10 nonprofit health service plans, and health maintenance organizations must comply 11 with this Act; and generally relating to submission of claims forms under health 12insurance.
