1	AN	ACT	concerning
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2 Agriculture - Cattle, Swine, and Poultry - Use of Antimicrobial Drugs

- 3 FOR the purpose of prohibiting a person from engaging in the nontherapeutic use of certain 4 antimicrobial drugs in certain cattle, swine, and poultry on or after a certain date; 5 requiring a certain farm operation to submit certain information under certain 6 circumstances to the Department of Agriculture on or before a certain date each year, 7 beginning on or before a certain date; requiring the Department to report to the 8 General Assembly on or before a certain date each year, beginning on or before a 9 certain date; authorizing the Secretary of Agriculture to impose a certain penalty; 10 providing for the application of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally 11 relating to the use of antimicrobial drugs in cattle, swine, and poultry.

- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 19 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article Agriculture
- 21 SUBTITLE 10. USE OF ANTIMICROBIAL DRUGS.
- 22 **3–1001.**

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- 1 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 2 INDICATED.
- 3 (B) "MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG" MEANS A DRUG OR 4 DERIVATIVE OF A DRUG THAT IS:
- 5 (1) (I) MADE FROM A MOLD OR BACTERIUM THAT KILLS OR SLOWS 6 THE GROWTH OF OTHER MICROBES, SPECIFICALLY BACTERIA; AND
- 7 (II) USED IN HUMAN BEINGS OR INTENDED FOR USE IN HUMAN 8 BEINGS TO TREAT OR PREVENT DISEASE OR INFECTION; OR
- 9 (2) LISTED IN APPENDIX A OF THE FEDERAL FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION'S GUIDANCE FOR INDUSTRY #152, INCLUDING CRITICALLY IMPORTANT, HIGHLY IMPORTANT, OR IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUGS.
- 12 (C) (1) "NONTHERAPEUTIC USE" MEANS THE USE OF A MEDICALLY 13 IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG IN AGRICULTURAL ANIMAL PRODUCTION IN THE 14 ABSENCE OF A DOCUMENTED DISEASE OR INFECTION.
- 15 **(2) "NONTHERAPEUTIC USE" INCLUDES:**
- 16 (I) GROWTH PROMOTION;
- 17 (II) FEED EFFICIENCY;
- 18 (III) WEIGHT GAIN;
- 19 (IV) ROUTINE DISEASE PREVENTION; OR
- 20 (V) ANY OTHER ROUTINE PURPOSE.
- 21 (D) (1) "ROUTINE DISEASE PREVENTION" MEANS THE USE OF A 22 MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG IN AGRICULTURAL ANIMAL 23 PRODUCTION TO PREVENT DISEASE OR INFECTION.
- 24 (2) "ROUTINE DISEASE PREVENTION" DOES NOT INCLUDE THE USE 25 OF A MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG TO CONTROL THE SPREAD OF 26 DISEASE OR INFECTION IN A BARN OR EQUIVALENT ANIMAL HOUSING UNIT IF THE 27 ANTIMICROBIAL USE IS FOR:
 - (I) A LIMITED AND MEDICALLY APPROPRIATE DURATION; AND

- 1 (II) ANIMALS THAT HAVE BEEN DEEMED HIGH RISK FOR 2 DISEASE OR INFECTION.
- 3 **3–1002.**
- 4 THIS SUBTITLE DOES NOT APPLY TO ANTIMICROBIAL USE IN:
- 5 (1) DAIRY CATTLE;
- 6 (2) CATTLE ON A FARM OPERATION THAT SELLS LESS THAN 200 7 CATTLE PER YEAR;
- 8 (3) SWINE ON A FARM OPERATION THAT SELLS LESS THAN 200 SWINE 9 PER YEAR; OR
- 10 (4) POULTRY ON A FARM OPERATION THAT SELLS LESS THAN **60,000** 11 BIRDS PER YEAR.
- 12 **3–1003.**
- ON OR AFTER OCTOBER 1, 2016, A PERSON MAY NOT ENGAGE IN THE
- 14 NONTHERAPEUTIC USE OF A MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG IN
- 15 CATTLE, SWINE, OR POULTRY PRODUCED IN THE STATE FOR HUMAN CONSUMPTION.
- 16 **3–1004.**
- 17 (A) ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1, 2017, AND EACH OCTOBER 1 THEREAFTER,
- 18 A FARM OPERATION IN WHICH A MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG IS
- 19 USED IN CATTLE, SWINE, OR POULTRY SHALL SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT:
- 20 (1) THE PERCENT OF THE HERD OR FLOCK THAT WAS TREATED WITH
- 21 A MEDICALLY IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG;
- 22 (2) THE CLASS AND TYPE OF EACH MEDICALLY IMPORTANT
- 23 ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG USED;
- 24 (3) THE DURATION OF ADMINISTRATION OF EACH MEDICALLY
- 25 IMPORTANT ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG USED; AND
- 26 (4) THE MEDICAL PURPOSE FOR USING THE MEDICALLY IMPORTANT
- 27 ANTIMICROBIAL DRUG, INCLUDING DISEASE PREVENTION, DISEASE CONTROL, OR
- 28 DISEASE TREATMENT.

- 1 (B) ON OR BEFORE DECEMBER 1, 2017, AND EACH DECEMBER 1
- 2 THEREAFTER, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL REPORT TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY, IN
- 3 ACCORDANCE WITH § 2-1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, ON THE
- 4 INFORMATION SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION, AGGREGATED
- 5 BY EACH FARM OPERATION.

- THE SECRETARY MAY IMPOSE AN ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY, NOT EXCEEDING \$2,000, ON A PERSON THAT VIOLATES THIS SUBTITLE.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 10 October 1, 2015.
