18 (A) BEFORE JUNE 1, 2016, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL ESTABLISH A SICKLE 19 **CELL DISEASE OUTREACH PROGRAM THAT:**

20(1) HAS A GOAL OF DECREASING THE USE OF ACUTE CARE SERVICES 21BY INDIVIDUALS WHO HAVE SICKLE CELL DISEASE; AND
