1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Charles County – Correctional Officers’ Bill of Rights**

3 FOR the purpose of altering, for purposes of the Charles County Correctional Officers’ Bill
4 of Rights, the definition of “correctional officer” to exclude an officer who is in
5 probationary status on initial entry into the correctional agency, subject to a certain
6 exception; and generally relating to the rights of a correctional officer in Charles
7 County.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
14 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 **Article – Correctional Services**

16 11–1101.

17 (b) **(1)** “Correctional officer” has the meaning stated in § 8–201 of this article.

18 **(2) “CORRECTIONAL OFFICER” DOES NOT INCLUDE AN OFFICER WHO**
19 **IS IN PROBATIONARY STATUS ON INITIAL ENTRY INTO THE SHERIFF’S OFFICE**

4 October 1, 2015.
