## Electric Companies - Customers - Security Deposits

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring an electric company to notify customers regarding the reasons for which a customer may be required to pay a security deposit by prominently 4 5 publishing notice in certain manners; requiring an electric company to give certain 6 written notice to a certain customer at least a certain period of time before imposing 7 a security deposit; requiring the notice to include certain information; requiring an 8 electric company to attempt to work with a customer to avoid imposing a security 9 deposit during a certain period; and generally relating to the imposition of security deposits by electric companies. 10

- 16 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 17 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- 20 (A) EACH ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL NOTIFY CUSTOMERS REGARDING THE
- 21 REASONS FOR WHICH THE ELECTRIC COMPANY MAY REQUIRE A CUSTOMER TO PAY
- 22 A SECURITY DEPOSIT BY PROMINENTLY PUBLISHING NOTICE:
  - (1) ON THE ELECTRIC COMPANY'S WEB SITE;

- 1 (2) IN ALL LITERATURE PUBLISHED BY THE ELECTRIC COMPANY FOR 2 CUSTOMERS REGARDING BILL PAYMENT; AND
- 3 (3) IN EACH CUSTOMER'S BILL.
- 4 (B) (1) AN ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL GIVE WRITTEN NOTICE TO AN 5 EXISTING CUSTOMER AT LEAST 30 DAYS BEFORE THE ELECTRIC COMPANY MAY 6 REQUIRE THE CUSTOMER TO PAY A SECURITY DEPOSIT.
- 7 (2) THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER PARAGRAPH (1) OF THIS 8 SUBSECTION SHALL INCLUDE CLEAR INSTRUCTIONS ON HOW THE CUSTOMER MAY 9 AVOID THE IMPOSITION OF A REQUIRED SECURITY DEPOSIT.
- 10 (3) FOLLOWING THE 30-DAY NOTICE PERIOD, BUT BEFORE IMPOSING
  11 A SECURITY DEPOSIT REQUIREMENT, THE ELECTRIC COMPANY SHALL ATTEMPT TO
  12 WORK WITH THE CUSTOMER TO AVOID THE IMPOSITION OF A REQUIRED SECURITY
  13 DEPOSIT BY:
- 14 (I) ENTERING INTO PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS; OR
- 15 (II) IF THE CUSTOMER IS ELIGIBLE, PARTICIPATING IN AN 16 ENERGY ASSISTANCE PROGRAM.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2015.
