## A BILL ENTITLED

AN ACT concerning 1 2 The Hunger-Free Schools Act of 2015 3 FOR the purpose of altering a certain definition for a certain fiscal year to determine the 4 number of students used to calculate a certain grant for schools that participate in a 5 certain federal program; and generally relating to the compensatory education grant 6 for primary and secondary education. 7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments, Article – Education 8 9 Section 5-207(a)(3)10 Annotated Code of Maryland (2014 Replacement Volume and 2014 Supplement) 11 12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 13 14 Article - Education 5-207.15 16 Except as provided in subparagraph (ii) of this paragraph, (a) (3)(i) 17 "compensatory education enrollment count" means the number of students eligible for free 18 or reduced price meals for the prior fiscal year. 19 For fiscal year 2004, "compensatory education enrollment 20 count" means the greater of: 211. The number of students eligible for free or reduced price 22meals for the prior fiscal year; or

- 25(III) FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CALCULATION UNDER SUBPARAGRAPH (II)2B OF THIS PARAGRAPH, THE SCHOOLS PARTICIPATING IN THE 26 27 COMMUNITY ELIGIBILITY PROGRAM DURING THE PILOT YEAR MAY USE THE 28 PERCENTAGE OF STUDENTS IDENTIFIED FOR FREE AND REDUCED PRICE MEALS 29 DURING THE PILOT YEAR.
- 30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June 31 1, 2015.
