4 FOR the purpose of repealing the authority to use work zone speed control systems to enforce certain highway speed laws within work zones; requiring the publishers of 5 6 the Annotated Code of Maryland, in consultation with and subject to the approval of 7 the Department of Legislative Services, to correct any references throughout the 8 Annotated Code that are rendered incorrect by this Act and to describe any 9 corrections in an editor's note following the section affected; and generally relating 10 to the repeal of provisions of law authorizing the use of work zone speed control 11 systems.
