SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 (A) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION, A 17 RESTAURANT THAT OFFERS A CHILDREN'S MENU OF MEAL OPTIONS OR OFFERS A 18 MEAL THAT IS REPRESENTED AS A CHILD'S MEAL MAY INCLUDE ONLY BOTTLED 19 WATER, LOW-FAT MILK, OR 100% FRUIT JUICE AS A BEVERAGE IN THE PRICE OF THE 20 MENU OPTION OR MEAL.

21(B)A RESTAURANT MAY OFFER ANY LAWFUL NONALCOHOLIC BEVERAGE TO22A MINOR FOR A CHARGE.
