SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

## IF AN AGENCY PARTICIPATING IN AN INVESTIGATION UNDER § 5-706 OF THIS SUBTITLE HAS REASONABLE GROUNDS TO BELIEVE THAT A PERSON HAS FAILED TO REPORT SUSPECTED ABUSE OR NEGLECT AS REQUIRED BY § 5-704 OF THIS SUBTITLE, THE AGENCY SHALL:

(1) IF THE PERSON IS A HEALTH PRACTITIONER, FILE A COMPLAINT WITH THE APPROPRIATE LICENSING BOARD IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS of the Health Occupations Article;

(2) IF THE PERSON IS A POLICE OFFICER, FILE A COMPLAINT WITH
