- 13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

- 17 (a) (1) [Except] SUBJECT TO PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION AND
- 18 **EXCEPT** as provided in subsection (b) of this section, with the approval of the Board of

- 20 [(1)] (I) that the Governor considers unnecessary; or
- 21 [(2)] (II) that is subject to budgetary reductions required under the budget
- 22 bill as approved by the General Assembly.

28	(iii) the Maryland School for the Blind; or

the salary of a public officer, during the term of office.

2 (3) Except as provided in § 8–109 of the State Personnel and Pensions 3 Article, the Governor may not reduce an appropriation for the salary of any nontemporary 4 employee in the State Personnel Management System.
