- 22 (1) TEACHES THE MEDICAL PROCEDURE WITHOUT THE USE OF AN

- 1 (2) IS USED BY AT LEAST ONE OTHER MEDICAL SCHOOL IN THE 2 STATE.
- 3 (B) A PERSON WHO VIOLATES SUBSECTION (A) OF THIS SECTION IS GUILTY
 4 OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING
 5 \$1,000 FOR EACH ANIMAL USED.
- 6 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 7 October 1, 2015.
