A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

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Harford County - Department of Public Works - Smart Water Meters

3 FOR the purpose of requiring the Harford County Department of Public Works to provide 4 certain customers with notice of its intention to install smart water meters under 5 certain circumstances; establishing a process by which a certain customer will be 6 deemed to have given permission to the Department to install a smart water meter 7 on the customer's premises; requiring the Department to pay to a customer a certain 8 amount if the Department installs a smart water meter on the customer's premises 9 without permission; requiring the Department to replace a smart water meter with 10 a standard water meter on a customer's premises under certain circumstances; 11 authorizing the Department to impose a certain additional charge for the use of a 12 standard water meter under certain circumstances; prohibiting the Department 13 from imposing a certain additional charge for the use of a standard water meter 14 under certain circumstances; providing for the application of this Act; defining 15 certain terms; and generally relating to the installation and use of smart water 16 meters in Harford County.

- 22 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 23 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 24 Article Environment
- 25 **9–1112.**

- 1 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS 2 INDICATED.
- 3 (2) "DEPARTMENT" MEANS THE HARFORD COUNTY DEPARTMENT 4 OF PUBLIC WORKS.
- 5 (3) "SMART WATER METER" MEANS A WATER METER THAT IS:
- 6 (I) CAPABLE OF MEASURING AND STORING WATER FLOW DATA 7 IN TIME INTERVALS; AND
- 8 (II) IS EQUIPPED FOR TWO-WAY COMMUNICATION WITH A 9 REMOTE LOCATION.
- 10 (4) "STANDARD WATER METER" MEANS ANY WATER METER OTHER 11 THAN A SMART WATER METER.
- 12 (B) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY TO HARFORD COUNTY.
- 13 (C) (1) IF THE DEPARTMENT CHOOSES TO INSTALL SMART WATER
 14 METERS IN THE COUNTY, THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE WRITTEN NOTICE TO
- 15 EACH AFFECTED CUSTOMER OF ITS INTENTION TO INSTALL SMART WATER METERS.
- 16 (2) IN THE NOTICE REQUIRED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION, THE 17 DEPARTMENT SHALL PROVIDE EACH CUSTOMER WITH THE OPPORTUNITY TO
- 18 REFUSE TO PERMIT THE INSTALLATION OF A SMART WATER METER ON THE
- 19 CUSTOMER'S PREMISES.
- 20 (3) A CUSTOMER IS DEEMED TO HAVE GIVEN PERMISSION TO THE 21 DEPARTMENT TO INSTALL A SMART WATER METER ON THE CUSTOMER'S PREMISES:
- 22 (I) ON RECEIPT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF A RETURNED NOTICE 23 EXPLICITLY GRANTING PERMISSION; OR
- 24 (II) IF THE NOTICE IS NOT RETURNED TO THE DEPARTMENT 25 WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER THE RECEIPT OF THE NOTICE BY THE CUSTOMER.
- 26 (4) IF THE DEPARTMENT INSTALLS A SMART WATER METER ON A CUSTOMER'S PREMISES WITHOUT PERMISSION OF THE CUSTOMER, THE 28 DEPARTMENT SHALL PAY TO THE CUSTOMER THE SUM OF \$500.

- 1 (D) ON RECEIPT OF A WRITTEN REQUEST OF A CUSTOMER, THE 2 DEPARTMENT SHALL REPLACE A SMART WATER METER ON THE CUSTOMER'S 3 PREMISES WITH A STANDARD WATER METER.
- 4 (E) THE DEPARTMENT MAY IMPOSE AN ADDITIONAL CHARGE OF UP TO \$7 5 PER MONTH FOR THE USE OF A STANDARD WATER METER.
- 6 NOTWITHSTANDING SUBSECTION (E) \mathbf{OF} THIS SECTION, 7 DEPARTMENT MAY NOT IMPOSE ANY ADDITIONAL CHARGES ON A CUSTOMER FOR 8 THE USE OF A STANDARD WATER METER IF THE CUSTOMER PROVIDES TO THE DEPARTMENT A NOTE FROM A PHYSICIAN LICENSED TO PRACTICE MEDICINE IN THE 9 STATE THAT INDICATES THAT THE CUSTOMER OR A MEMBER OF THE CUSTOMER'S 10 11 HOUSEHOLD SUFFERS FROM AN ILLNESS RELATED TO THE EXPOSURE TO RADIO 12 FREQUENCIES.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall be construed to apply only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect on or application to the installation of smart water meters in Harford County before the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 18 October 1, 2015.
