CHAPTER _____

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Carroll County – Gaming Events**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing certain organizations in Carroll County to conduct a card
4 game, card tournament, or casino event under certain circumstances; requiring an
5 organization to obtain a certain permit from the Board of County Commissioners of
6 Carroll County before conducting a card game, card tournament, or casino event;
7 requiring an organization that seeks a permit to meet certain requirements;
8 specifying that a card game, card tournament, or casino event may be managed and
9 operated by certain organizations; prohibiting an operator of a card game, card
10 tournament, or casino event from receiving certain compensation; requiring a certain
11 volunteer or player in a card game, card tournament, or casino event to be of a certain
12 age; specifying that a permit holder may receive a certain maximum number of
13 permits in a calendar year; providing a certain time limit on a card game, card
14 tournament, or casino event; specifying that a permit is not transferable; requiring
15 that proceeds from a card game, card tournament, or casino event be used for certain

 2 specifying that the operation of a card game, card tournament, or casino event may
 3 not occur after a certain time on Sunday; authorizing a permit holder under this Act
 4 to charge only a preset entrance fee; requiring participants in a card game, card
 5 tournament, or casino event to use tokens and not cash for wagering under certain
 6 circumstances; prohibiting a permit holder from exchanging tokens under certain
 7 circumstances; requiring a permit holder to submit a financial report ~~to the Carroll~~
 8 ~~County Sheriff's Office~~ *and certain information about winners of prizes to the Board*
 9 *of County Commissioners for Carroll County* under certain circumstances;
 10 authorizing the Board of County Commissioners to adopt certain regulations;

23 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,

24 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

25 **Article – Criminal Law**

26 13–906.

27 (a) Notwithstanding § 13–903 of this subtitle **AND EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN**
 28 **SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION AND § 13–906.1 OF THIS SUBTITLE**, a person may
 29 not conduct a card game, dice game, roulette, or casino [night unless the person is a senior
 30 center site council that conducts a card game under subsection (b) of this section] **EVENT**.

31 (b) (1) A senior center site council may conduct a card game in a senior center
 32 5 days per week, excluding Sunday.

33 (2) A senior center site council may not:

34 (i) award a prize of money exceeding \$5 to a winner in each session;
 35 and

36 (ii) charge a participant more than \$1 to play one session.

1 (3) All money that remains after prizes are awarded shall be distributed to
2 the senior center site council.

4 (A) (1) IN THIS SECTION THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
5 INDICATED.

6 (2) "CASINO EVENT" INCLUDES THE PLAY OF CARD GAMES, DICE
7 GAMES, AND ROULETTE.

8 (3) "PERMIT" MEANS A PERMIT TO CONDUCT A CARD GAME, CARD
9 TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT.

10 (B) BEFORE AN ORGANIZATION MAY CONDUCT A CARD GAME, CARD
11 TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT, THE ORGANIZATION SHALL OBTAIN A PERMIT
12 FROM THE ~~COUNTY COMMISSIONERS~~ BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR
13 CARROLL COUNTY.

14 (C) TO QUALIFY FOR A PERMIT, AN ORGANIZATION SHALL BE A BONA FIDE:

15 (1) AMATEUR ATHLETIC ORGANIZATION;

16 (2) CHARITABLE ORGANIZATION;

17 (3) CIVIC ORGANIZATION;

18 (4) FRATERNAL ORGANIZATION;

19 (5) HOSPITAL;

20 (6) RELIGIOUS ORGANIZATION;

21 (7) VOLUNTEER FIRE COMPANY; OR

22 (8) WAR VETERANS' ORGANIZATION.

23 (D) (1) A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT MAY BE:

24 (I) MANAGED AND OPERATED BY THE ORGANIZATION THAT IS
25 THE PERMIT HOLDER; OR

1 (II) MANAGED BY THE ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT
2 HOLDER AND OPERATED BY ANOTHER ORGANIZATION LISTED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF
3 THIS SECTION.

4 (2) (I) AN OPERATOR OF A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR
5 CASINO EVENT MAY NOT RECEIVE COMPENSATION.

6 (II) TO VOLUNTEER AS AN OPERATOR OF, ~~OR TO PARTICIPATE~~
7 ~~AS A PLAYER IN,~~ A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT, AN
8 INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE AT LEAST 18 YEARS OLD.

9 (III) TO PARTICIPATE IN A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR
10 CASINO EVENT, AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE AT LEAST 21 YEARS OLD.

11 (E) (1) AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY RECEIVE
12 NOT MORE THAN FOUR PERMITS IN A CALENDAR YEAR.

13 (2) A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT MAY NOT
14 LAST LONGER THAN 24 CONSECUTIVE HOURS.

15 (F) A PERMIT IS NOT TRANSFERABLE.

16 (G) (1) PROCEEDS FROM A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO
17 EVENT CONDUCTED UNDER THIS SECTION:

18 (I) SHALL BE USED TO BENEFIT A CHARITY OR TO FURTHER
19 THE PURPOSE OF THE PERMIT HOLDER; AND

20 (II) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN PARAGRAPH (2) OF THIS
21 SUBSECTION, MAY NOT ~~BENEFIT FINANCIALLY OR BE USED FOR THE~~ BE USED FOR
22 THE FINANCIAL BENEFIT OR THE PERSONAL USE OF AN INDIVIDUAL OR A GROUP OF
23 INDIVIDUALS.

24 (2) ON APPROVAL OF THE ~~COUNTY COMMISSIONERS~~ BOARD OF
25 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR CARROLL COUNTY, PROCEEDS MAY BE USED TO
26 BENEFIT A FAMILY WITH MEDICAL NEEDS.

27 (H) A PERMIT MAY NOT AUTHORIZE THE OPERATION OF A CARD GAME,
28 CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT AFTER 1 A.M. ON SUNDAY.

29 (I) (1) AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY CHARGE
30 ONLY A PRESET ENTRANCE FEE FOR A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO
31 EVENT.

1 (2) PARTICIPANTS IN A CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO
2 EVENT SHALL RECEIVE TOKENS FOR WAGERING IN EXCHANGE FOR THE ENTRANCE
3 FEE.

4 (3) A PARTICIPANT MAY PURCHASE ADDITIONAL TOKENS, AT A TOTAL
5 COST NOT EXCEEDING 100% OF THE ENTRANCE FEE, DURING A CARD GAME, CARD
6 TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT.

7 (4) AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT ALLOW
8 CASH TO BE USED FOR WAGERING.

9 (J) AN ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT HOLDER MAY NOT EXCHANGE
10 TOKENS USED IN WAGERING FOR:

11 (1) AN ITEM OF MERCHANDISE THAT IS WORTH MORE THAN \$10,000;

12 (2) MONEY; OR

13 (3) AN ITEM OF MERCHANDISE HAVING A VALUE THAT IS DIFFERENT
14 FROM THE FAIR MARKET RETAIL VALUE OF THE ITEM OF MERCHANDISE THAT WAS
15 RECEIVED FOR THE TOKENS.

16 (K) ~~(I)~~ WITHIN 60 DAYS AFTER HOLDING A CARD GAME, CARD
17 TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT, THE ORGANIZATION THAT IS THE PERMIT
18 HOLDER SHALL SUBMIT TO THE ~~CARROLL COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE~~ BOARD OF
19 COUNTY COMMISSIONERS FOR CARROLL COUNTY:

20 (1) A FINANCIAL REPORT THAT LISTS THE RECEIPTS AND
21 EXPENDITURES FOR THE CARD GAME, CARD TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT; AND

22 (2) THE NAME, ADDRESS, AND SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER OF A
23 PARTICIPANT THAT IS DECLARED THE WINNER AT A CARD GAME, CARD
24 TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT OF A PRIZE FOR WHICH ISSUANCE OF INTERNAL
25 REVENUE SERVICE FORM W-2G OR A SUBSTANTIALLY EQUIVALENT FORM IS
26 REQUIRED.

27 ~~(2) THE CARROLL COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE SHALL FORWARD THE~~
28 ~~FINANCIAL REPORTS TO THE STATE LOTTERY AND GAMING CONTROL AGENCY.~~

29 (L) IN ADDITION TO BEING SUBJECT TO § 13-909 OF THIS SUBTITLE, AN
30 ORGANIZATION THAT IS FOUND TO HAVE VIOLATED THIS SECTION IS INELIGIBLE TO
31 RECEIVE A PERMIT UNDER THIS SECTION FOR A PERIOD ~~NOT EXCEEDING~~ OF 5
32 YEARS.

1 **(M) THE ~~COUNTY COMMISSIONERS~~ BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS**
 2 **FOR CARROLL COUNTY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS SECTION,**
 3 **INCLUDING REGULATIONS TO GOVERN:**

4 **(1) THE ISSUING OF PERMITS;**

5 **(2) PERMIT FEES; AND**

6 **(3) THE CONDUCT AND MANAGEMENT OF A CARD GAME, CARD**
 7 **TOURNAMENT, OR CASINO EVENT IN A MANNER TO PREVENT FRAUD AND PROTECT**
 8 **THE PUBLIC.**
