2	Transportation – Thomas J. Hatem Memorial Bridge – Discounted Variable Toll
3	Rate for Commuters

4 FOR the purpose of requiring the Maryland Transportation Authority to establish a discounted variable toll rate for certain commuters to cross the Thomas J. Hatem 5 6 Memorial Bridge; setting the discounted variable toll rate at a certain amount and 7 applying the toll during certain hours each day; requiring certain persons to register 8 with the Authority and present documentation and other information to qualify for 9 the discounted variable toll rate; authorizing the Authority to adopt certain 10 regulations; and generally relating to a discounted variable toll rate for commuters 11 to cross the Thomas J. Hatem Memorial Bridge.

- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND,
- 18 That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 19 Article Transportation
- 20 4-406.
- 21 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "BRIDGE" MEANS THE THOMAS J. HATEM MEMORIAL
- 22 BRIDGE THAT CROSSES THE SUSQUEHANNA RIVER BETWEEN HARFORD COUNTY
- 23 AND CECIL COUNTY.

- 1 (B) THE AUTHORITY SHALL ESTABLISH A DISCOUNTED VARIABLE TOLL 2 RATE FOR ELIGIBLE COMMUTERS THAT CROSS THE BRIDGE BETWEEN THE HOURS 3 OF 5:00 A.M. AND 7:00 P.M. DAILY.
- 4 (C) THE DISCOUNTED VARIABLE TOLL RATE IS **50** PERCENT OF THE TOLL 5 RATE THAT OTHERWISE WOULD BE CHARGED BY THE AUTHORITY TO CROSS THE 6 BRIDGE DURING THE PERIODS SPECIFIED UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION.
- 7 (D) (1) THE AUTHORITY SHALL MAKE THE DISCOUNTED VARIABLE TOLL 8 RATE TO CROSS THE BRIDGE AVAILABLE TO AN ELIGIBLE COMMUTER WHO DRIVES 9 ANY CLASS OF VEHICLE ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION IN THIS STATE AND WHO 10 REGISTERS WITH THE AUTHORITY AS PROVIDED IN THIS SUBSECTION.
- 11 (2) A PERSON MAY REGISTER FOR A DISCOUNTED VARIABLE TOLL 12 RATE ONLY IF THE PERSON:
- 13 (I) SUBMITS AN APPLICATION AND REGISTERS WITH THE 14 AUTHORITY; AND
- 15 (II) PRESENTS DOCUMENTATION AND OTHER INFORMATION
 16 REQUIRED BY THE AUTHORITY TO VALIDATE THE PERSON'S STATUS AS A BRIDGE
 17 COMMUTER.
- 18 **(E)** THE AUTHORITY MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THIS 19 SECTION.
- SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 21 October 1, 2015.
